

## Austrian Winter Peas

Peas are a great option for livestock producers looking to hay or graze their cover crops, as well as fix some nitrogen! Peas can produce lots of high quality biomass, as well as fix up to 125# of N.

Due to their large seed size, peas can be challenging to utilize with small seed. They do best with other grains, as they need to be seeded 1" deep for best results.

Peas do not perform well in poorly drained soil.



<b>Seeding Method:</b>	Drill or plant
<b>Seeding Rate:</b>	20-50# in a mix for forage; 5-15# for soil health
<b>Seeding Depth:</b>	1"
<b>Seeding Dates:</b>	8/15 - 10/1
<b>Notes:</b>	Peas need inoculant to help fix their maximum potential nitrogen
